

Triaditza is a district of Sofia - the capital of Bulgaria. It is located in the southern parts of Sofia. The district has an areas of 9,8 km<sup>2</sup>.

It includes six neighbourhoods: Gotze Delchev, Strelbishte, Ivan Vazov, Manastirski livadi, Yujen park and Krastova voda.

As of 2008 Triaditza has a population of 67 367.

The district is a centre of attraction as for the guests of the town, thus for inhabitants of a capital: **Courts of justice; National Palace of Culture (NDK); Vitosha Str.; Pool Spartak; Yujen park; Pette Kusheta; Earth and Man National Museum; National Museum of Military History; Museum of MVR.**

### Landmarks:

#### - **The Church of St. George**

Churches of the 9th and the 10th century decorated in frescoes have not been preserved in Bulgaria. The earliest samples are of the end of the 10th and the beginning of the 11th century. These are fragments (eight angels) situated in the inner-vault space of the Church of St. George in Sofia. Famous also as the Rotunda, it is the only late antique building of the 4th century with preserved roof structure, which was designed for the festive ceremonies, which accompanied the visit of Emperor Constantine the Great to Serdika. During the invasion of the Huns in mid 5th century it was destroyed and later re-constructed as a church, which was turned into a mosque after the 14th century.

### Health:

#### - **Military Medical Academy (MMA)**

The Military Medical Academy was established in 1989, at the Ministry of Defense of Republic of Bulgaria, as an integrated complex for medical care, education and scientific research with the commitment to develop the military medical science, and to provide training, specialization and qualification of the military medical staff for the purpose of ensuring the fighting strength and combat readiness of the Bulgarian Armed Forces, preservation and recovery of the military servicemen's health.

#### - **National Center of Public Health Protection**

The National Centre of Public Health Protection (NCPHP) develops projects and programmes for disease prevention and health promotion. It provides consultations to the health administration and the whole health network. NCPHP is also involved in international cooperation with EU, WHO, NATO, UNDP, FAO, UNICEF, etc.

#### - **Medical faculty- Sofia**

The Medical Faculty – Sofia is the oldest medical higher education institution in Bulgaria.

The Medical Faculty has a structure of 47 departments and clinical centers, where highly qualified lecturers, of whom 116 professors, 276 associate professors and 960 assistant professors, are working to deliver a high level of education and up-to-date training. The level of teaching is professional and it is based on updated syllabuses.

About 35 000 doctors have graduated from the Medical Faculty, from the moment of its establishment up to the present day.
